EDGEWISE THERAPEUTICS REPORTS POSITIVE RESULTS ON SEVASEMTEN* PROGRAM FOR BECKER AND DUCHENNE MUSCULAR DYSTROPHIES

On June 26, 2025, Edgewise shared a press release (which can be found [here](#)) announcing new data in Becker from MESA, the open-label trial that provides continued access to sevasemten* to participants who were previously enrolled in Edgewise trials. The release also included new Phase 2 findings from the Duchenne program. Key highlights include:

- New MESA data from participants with Becker in the previous ARCH and CANYON studies, showing consistent functional and safety findings.
- Encouraging preliminary Phase 2 results from the Duchenne trials, LYNX and FOX, which identified the 10 mg dose to be studied further. These results will help guide design for a potential Phase 3 pivotal trial.

The Becker pivotal cohort, GRAND CANYON, remains ongoing. A recent FDA meeting provided a clear regulatory path toward potential approval of sevasemten* for Becker.

Parent Project Muscular Dystrophy hosted a webinar on Friday, June 27th where Joanne Donovan, Edgewise's Chief Medical Officer, walked through the findings and outlined next steps for both the Becker and Duchenne programs. The recording of that webinar can be found [here](#).
